COOKIES POLICY

The below information is Badminton Wales Cookie Policy in compliance with the EU Law.

What is a cookie?

A cookie is a small text file with information that a website puts on your hard disk, in order to remember something about you at a later time. Cookies tends to record your preferences when using a particular site and are commonly used to rotate banner adverts, so the user receives different adverts based on previous website activity. What is the new EU Cookie Law?

The EU Cookie Law is the EU e-Privacy Directive that came into action on 26th May 2012 and what it means is that as a website based in Europe, you have to get your visitors informed consent before placing a cookie on their machine. Here is a [link to the ICO website](#) detailing the law.

What information does Badminton Wales store?

We use Google Analytics and other analytic software which logs your IP Address, Country, State, Visit Duration, Pages visited, how many times you have visited, internal website clicks, search engine query and other website visitor information.
